Qualified staff present the classes in an interesting and informal manner. The NQF as well as CAPS learning programmes are applied in the classes as prescribed by the Department of Education.

The classes are well appointed with plenty of room for play and learning. All classes are equipped with the necessary educational toys to entertain the little ones. We also follow a strict routine in class to ensure all learning areas are covered.

The playground is safe and child-friendly with ample climbing apparatus to develop the large muscles.

The younger children make use of their own play area which is separate from the older children and is adapted for their safety.

We also visit the Primary School regularly and have fun playing on their rugby field which has a direct access from the Nursery School's premises.

Christian values are upheld at school and a Bible lesson is also offered in class every day.

LITTLE CHICKS (FROM 3 MONTHS)

Our Baby Centre is well furnished to the standards of the health department. It is a beautiful, spacious, and sunny room with ample fixtures to stimulate and keep the little ones busy. Loving and well-trained staff with many years of experience take care of the babies daily and believe in physical contact, they receive lots of hugs and love throughout the day. Staff are also trained in first aid so parents can leave their little ones in our capable hands with a safe heart. Babies are constantly monitored, and notes are made in baby's book, so Mommy and Daddy always know what happened at school. Strict measures are applied with hygiene, only "Milton" is used for disinfection as well as for washing floors, cots, mattresses, and toys. Parents are immediately contacted if baby becomes ill. Babies also follow a routine such as play, sleep and mealtimes. Communication through books, personal messages and photos throughout the day.

Extracurricular Activity – Babynastix (Optional)

- Separate kitchen & changing area
- Cubicles for every baby's necessities.
- Ample toys to develop and stimulate the little ones.
- Music, stories, and development programme
- Outdoor play every day, except in winter (separate play area)
- Cot for every baby
- Basic bedding that is changed daily.

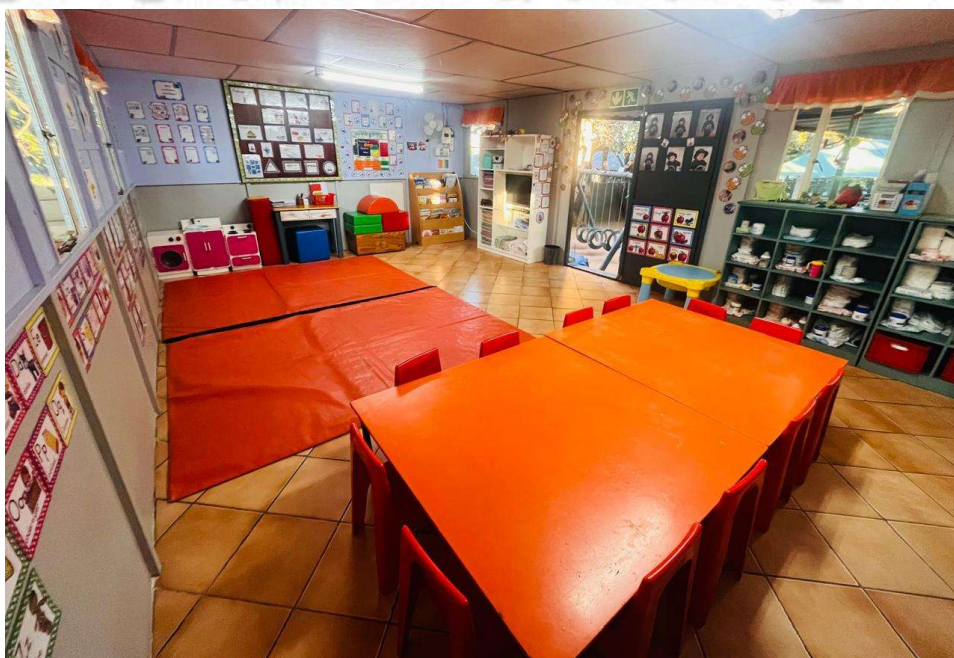


LITTLE BUG (18 – 2 years)

Our toddlers are busy little bodies and are constructively engaged in sensory and discovery play. The NQF and ELDAS are applied daily in the classes to ensure that they develop and thrive in all areas. It means a lot of outdoor play, large and small motor activities as well as sand and water play.

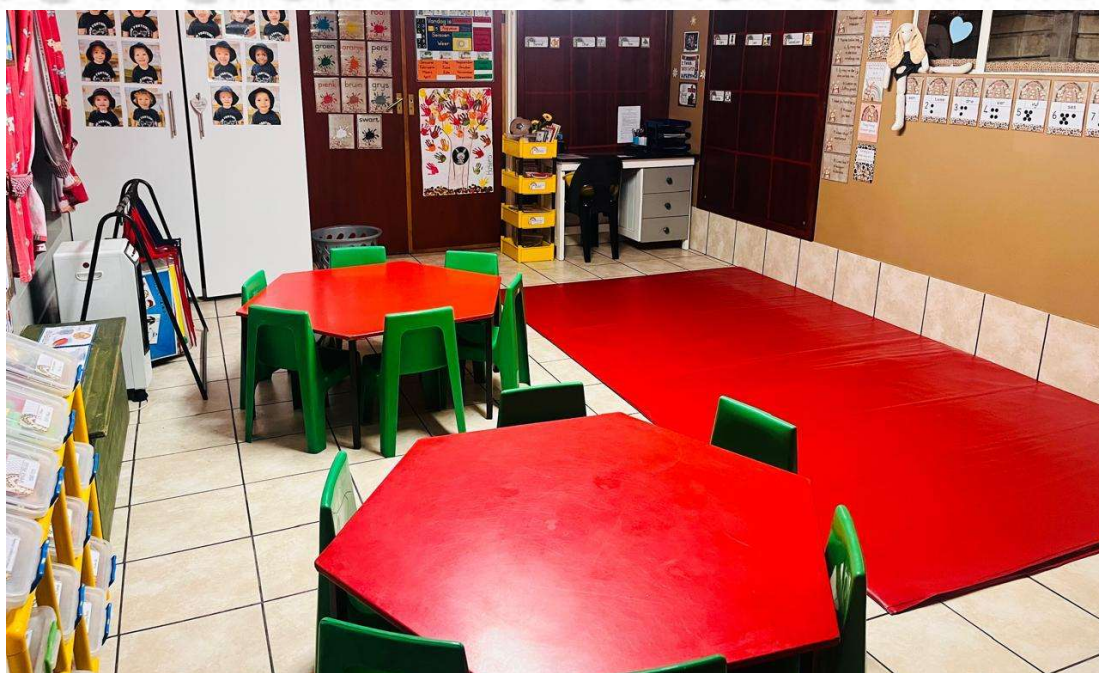
BUNNY CLASS (2 – 3 years)

We are growing up and starting to show more interest in the class activities and enjoy learning new things. Pencil grip and handling of the scissors are practised weekly, and they enjoy cutting clay, cardboard, and magazines. Sensory activities are great fun, and this group enjoys playing outside. Outside play develops their large as well as small muscles, balance, coordination, and midline crossing. Their social skills continuously develop through free and fantasy play and unconsciously teach them to solve problems and conflicts. Teacher plans learning-through-play lessons weekly and joins the activities in maths, language, and life skills. Each child has a class file for activities such as drawing, cutting, shapes, colours, colouring etc. The children are very proud to show off their files to mommy and daddy.

- More seriousness is given to potty training, and we aim to have all the children completely off the diapers, bottles, and pacifiers by the end of each year.

PUPPY & OWL CLASS (SENIOR SECTION (3 – 5 YEARS))

The children have now reached the age where they can concentrate for longer periods of time, therefore their rings are longer than at the junior section. Physical, emotional, social, and scholastic development of the kindergarten continues. There is also a lot of focus on self-reliance and teaching the buddies to do things for themselves. Own creativity in their artwork is important and they are encouraged to find a solution to problems. Physical development is constantly rehearsed to reinforce the large muscles. Pencil grip and the use of the scissors are also very important, and activities are offered daily for their practice. Mathematics for example Forms, concepts, grouping, and time are rehearsed in a concrete manner. Language is also very important, and we strive to lay a strong foundation around language skills and to expand the children's vocabulary. The daily learning program provides separate rings for language, math, and life skills. The younger children follow the NQF learning programme which ties in with the CAPS.

Senior children may enrol in the following extracurricular activities: Swimming, Monkeynastix, Tumbling Tigers, Ballet, Rugby, Computers, Swimming, Karate, Abacus Mathematics – OPTIONAL (We recommend that all Gr RR & R children enrol in Abacus Mathematics, Computers and Swimming. They benefit immensely from the maths lessons, and it is also important that the children are already able to swim in the year they go to primary school)
